Friends in Christ,

As Americans we can give thanks to God for a heritage of faith that has been passed down through the generations. We can read about the faith of godly men and women in the history of our country. Of the 250 people we call Founding Fathers, the vast majority, by their own testimony, were Christians. They believed in the Good News of Jesus Christ. They confessed that He died on the cross for our sins and rose again. These men and women, and millions of their fellow citizens, prayed for their nation and the future of their country. They witnessed to the next generation. And we are the recipients of those answered prayers and faithful witness.

We who have been blessed in the United States with the Good News of Jesus Christ must confess to the Lord that we have often not been faithful in sharing that Good News. For this we must repent. At the same time we give thanks to God for the Good News of His forgiveness, which is ours through faith in Christ. Through His Holy Spirit we can be renewed to the task of spreading the Gospel right here in our community and country. In our prayers we can ask God graciously to allow our Christian heritage to be transmitted to the next generation.

In Deuteronomy chapter 8 the people of Israel were commanded by God to remember that they were set free from slavery in Egypt. The freedoms that we celebrate on the Fourth of July were never free. Many of the signers of the Declaration of Independence were hounded and persecuted, and some died for their beliefs.

On Independence Day, and throughout the month of July, we give thanks to God for those who gave their lives so that we may live in a free land. We give thanks to God for those who risked their lives to protect our freedoms. We also give thanks to God for those in the armed forces who are in harm's way so that we continue to enjoy the freedoms we have.

As a free people, we have a God-given responsibility to pray for our nation and leaders. We have the responsibility and calling to participate as citizens at the local, state, and national levels. And as a free people, we have the responsibility to exercise the freedom of worship that God has blessed us with in the United States.

In the month of July especially, we give thanks to God for the many blessings that He has showered upon us through our great nation, the United States of America. We pray to God for our nation, our leaders, and our fellow citizens. And we pray to God for ourselves, that He would keep us faithful always to our Savior, Jesus Christ.

St. Paul wrote to the Christians at Rome, "First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for all of you, because your faith is being reported all over the world" (Romans 1:8). The early church spread to the eastern regions around the Mediterranean Sea—regions that are no longer primarily populated by Christians. For centuries, Christianity found a place of growth in Europe. State-dominated churches, wars, communism, and secularism have taken a severe toll on the faith in Europe. Sadly, much of Europe is Christian in name only.

Here in the United States the Gospel of forgiveness and salvation through Christ alone has been deeply planted. Under the freedoms that we have experienced over the last two and a half centuries, the faith has grown and spread. And we in our day have a great opportunity not only to keep that faith alive, but also to help people of other nations have the opportunity to receive the Good News of forgiveness and salvation through Jesus alone.




